# Outline of services provided

- works with offenders and their 'families' to engage with services, safeguard vulnerable children and prevent inter-generational offending
- provides intensive, personal, social and practical support on a wide range of issues



# Typical clients

- works with complex, 'hard to reach' families within the wider community, referred from a range of agencies
- wrap-around, 'family social work'



# Indicative caseload

- 120 cases opened per year
- 180 children on caseload per year
- 400 families worked with since 2008
- 5 full-time equivalent staff

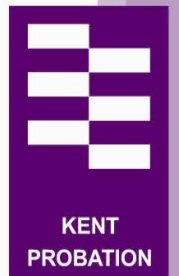

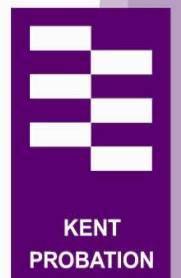
